

**BOROUGH OF INTERLAKEN
WORKSHOP MINUTES
DECEMBER 18, 2013
7:00 P.M. AT BOROUGH HALL**

The meeting of the Borough of Interlaken was called to order at 7:00 p.m., by Mayor Nohilly. The following statement was read by Borough Administrator Reibrich. "The notice of the requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act has been satisfied by forwarding annual notice to the Coaster and Asbury Park Press. A copy of annual notice is posted on the Borough bulletin board and is on file in the Borough Clerk's office."

1. EAGLE SCOUT PRESENTATION – Evan Case made a presentation to the Council. Evan would like to complete a community project requirement to become an Eagle Scout.

Evan stated that he would like to rehabilitate areas along the shore of the lake, so they can be used for recreation. Evan would remove invasive foliage, build a stone pathway and supply benches/trash cans for the area.

Evan indicated that this would be done in two areas. The first area would be near the railroad tracks on the south side of the railroad bridge. The second area would be in the area near Interlaken Drive.

Councilman Parry asked how many hours the project would take.

Councilman Cohen asked about the expense of the project.

Evan indicated that he had over 40 people to help with the project and that materials would be recycled from Asbury Park to help with expenses.

Councilman Parry asked Council if approval was needed.

Mayor Nohilly stated that approval was not needed for the clean up, but asked Evan to come back to discuss the benches and trash cans placement and maintenance.

2. NEW BUSINESS – Don Nissim, Deal Lake Commission Representative, asked Council if he could arrange to come back to a future meeting to discuss developments regarding Deal Lake Cleanup. Recent changes at the NRCS and help from the DEP make more improvements possible.

3. COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC - No public comment.

4. ADJOURNMENT: With no further comments, Councilman Parry made a motion to adjourn at 7:30 p.m., seconded by Councilman Napoli and unanimously carried.
