

**BOROUGH OF INTERLAKEN
WORKSHOP MINUTES
MARCH 20, 2013
7:30 P.M. AT BOROUGH HALL**

The meeting of the Borough of Interlaken was called to order at 7:00 p.m., by Mayor Nohilly. It was followed by a salute to the flag and a moment of silence. The following statement was read by Borough Administrator Reibrich. "The notice of the requirements of the Open Public Meetings Act has been satisfied by forwarding annual notice to the Coaster and Asbury Park Press. A copy of annual notice is posted on the Borough bulletin board and is on file in the Borough Clerk's office."

1. **SLX INFRASTRUCTURE:** Councilman Napoli asked to have this conversation tabled and held in Executive Session. At this time, he brought up the proposed SLX resolution on the regular meeting agenda. He asked to have that resolution held till after the executive session meeting where action may be taken. Council President Miller asked to change the scope of the executive session meeting by adding "DPW contract negotiations" to the list of items to be discussed. The Council agreed on all points.
2. **FALLEN TREE REMOVAL:** Councilman Napoli provided the Council with a proposed ordinance about the removal of felled trees. A brief discussion was had about whether to include this tree topic in the proposed tree ordinance or to have it as an ordinance that stands alone. The Council discussed the hardship of the tree ordinance being written to where the entire Council would agree to vote for its introduction and adoption. Mayor Nohilly asked Borough Attorney Shaklee to research and report on the draft felled tree ordinance at the next workshop meeting.
3. **NEW BUSINESS:** Councilman Napoli asked to have a full council budget review on the next workshop. He said having a full council discussion before adoption of the budget is very important to the Governing Body and the resident taxpayers.

Mayor Nohilly reiterated that the two topics for the next workshop meeting are felled tree ordinance research and the 2013 budget.

4. **COMMENTS FROM THE PUBLIC:** Mayor Nohilly opened the floor for public comment. With no comments made, he closed the floor.
5. **ADJOURNMENT:** With no further comments, Council President Miller made a motion to adjourn at 7:20 p.m., seconded by Councilman Parry and unanimously carried.
