• Mrs. Wong reported that we received correspondence from the Commissioner of Education on our application for emergent relief. The Commissioner adopted the Order of the Administrative Law Judge granting permission of the status quo. The parties involved still have the ability to appeal. Mrs. Wong also reported that this letter just came in today and we have not had an opportunity to thoroughly discuss with the School Board Attorney.

10.0 PUBLIC PARTICIPATION

- Keith Miller Bridlemere Avenue Mr. Miller asked the following:
 - O Clarification on the ability to appeal. Mrs. Wong indicated that Asbury Park may file an appeal of the Commissioner's decision.
 - What has been approved? Mrs. Wong indicated that the status quo has been approved, wherein, the students of Interlaken may continue their education in the West Long Branch and Shore Regional schools, pending an ultimate determination on our petition to replace or supplement the current send-receive relationship with Asbury Park. The matter must now go back to the Office of Administrative Law for a plenary hearing.
 - O Would it be possible to have a copy of the Commissioner's decision letter for tomorrow night's Town Council Meeting? Mrs. Wong indicated that she would email a copy after speaking with the Board Attorney.
- Ollie Holmes 710 Raymere Avenue Mr. Holmes asked the following:
 - What is the status quo? Mrs. Wong indicated that the status quo is that the students of Interlaken may continue their education in the West Long Branch and Shore Regional schools.
 - O Will we end up like Seaside Heights as reported in the Asbury Park Press on June 10th? Mrs. Wong indicated that she did not read the newspaper article and does not know the circumstances in Seaside Heights. Mrs. Handerhan indicated that the Interlaken Board of Education's purpose was to avoid regionalization as it would be very expensive.
 - O Can the Board of Education meeting dates and times be posted somewhere other than on the Borough's website? Mr. Kotch indicated that by law, the notice of the meetings must be placed in the Asbury Park Press and in the Borough Hall, which we do. As an added measure we post this information on the Borough's website.
- Stan Colageski Buttermere Avenue Mr. Colageski asked if there will be meetings in July and August and if they will be at the normal time? Mrs. Wong indicated that we intend on having meetings in July and August, however, the exact dates and times are yet to be determined as we must coordinate with our School Board Attorney.
